

Quilt Size Chart and Calculator

Quilt	Mattress Size	Batting Size	Standard Quilt Size
Baby			30-inches x 40-inches
Crib	27-inches x 52-inches	45-inches x 60-inches	36-inches x 60-inches
Youth	33-inches x 66-inches		54-inches x 78-inches
Lap or Throw			50-inches x 65-inches
Twin	39-inches x 75-inches	72-inches x 90-inches	70-inches x 90-inches
Extra Long Twin	39-inches x 80-inches		70-inches x 95-inches
Double / Full	54-inches x 75-inches	81-inches x 96-inches	84-inches x 90-inches
Queen	60-inches x 80-inches	90-inches x 108-inches	90-inches x 95-inches
King	76-inches x 80-inches	120-inches x 120-inches	108-inches x 95-inches
California King	72-inches x 84-inches		102-inches x 100-inches

When considering the drop of a quilt, you need to consider the depth of the mattress

Depth	Dimensions
Standard	7-inches to 9-inches
Deep	10-inches to 15-inches
Extra Deep	15-inches to 22-inches

Calculate the quilt size for your bed: NOTE: I like to add a few inches to both width and length

WIDTH + (2 x DEPTH) + 4 = finished width

LENGTH + DEPTH + 4 = finished length

Example: For a twin quilt with a deep mattress:

39 + (2 x 10) + 4 = 63-inches for the width

75 + 10 + 4 = 89-inches for the length
