

## **Bargello Quilt Cutting Chart – Three Sizes**

inished Dimensions	Number of Fabric Prints	Strip Width	Strips per Fabric (WOF)	Total Strips	Border (optional)	Bindi
36" × 48"	8 prints + 1 background	2½″	2 strips	18 total	2" finished (cut 21/2")	1/4 yar
60" × 72"	10 prints + 1 background	2½″	3 strips	33 total	3" finished (cut 31/2")	½ yar
84" × 96"	12 prints + 1 background	2½″	4 strips	52 total	4" finished (cut 41/2")	¾ yar

## **Cutting Instructions:**

- 1. From each fabric print, cut the number of  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " wide strips listed above across the width of fabric (WOF).
- 2. Sew strips together in your chosen order to make a strip set.
- 3. Press seams alternately (odd strips up, even strips down) for nesting later.
- 4. Sub-cut the strip set into 2½" wide segments.
- 5. Rearrange the segments to create the wave or flame effect, following your Bargello layout.

## **Fabric Tips:**

Choose a gradient of colors (light  $\rightarrow$  dark) for flow. A jelly roll works perfectly for the baby size; use 1½ for throw and 2½ for queen.
