



Bargello Quilt Cutting Chart – Three Sizes

Finished Dimensions	Number of Fabric Prints	Strip Width	Strips per Fabric (WOF)	Total Strips	Border (optional)	Binding
36" × 48"	8 prints + 1 background	2½"	2 strips	18 total	2" finished (cut 2½")	¼ yard
60" × 72"	10 prints + 1 background	2½"	3 strips	33 total	3" finished (cut 3½")	½ yard
84" × 96"	12 prints + 1 background	2½"	4 strips	52 total	4" finished (cut 4½")	¾ yard

Cutting Instructions:

1. From each fabric print, cut the number of 2½" wide strips listed above across the width of fabric (WOF).
2. Sew strips together in your chosen order to make a strip set.
3. Press seams alternately (odd strips up, even strips down) for nesting later.
4. Sub-cut the strip set into 2½" wide segments.
5. Rearrange the segments to create the wave or flame effect, following your Bargello layout.

Fabric Tips:

Choose a gradient of colors (light → dark) for flow. A jelly roll works perfectly for the baby size; use 1½" for throw and 2½" for queen.
